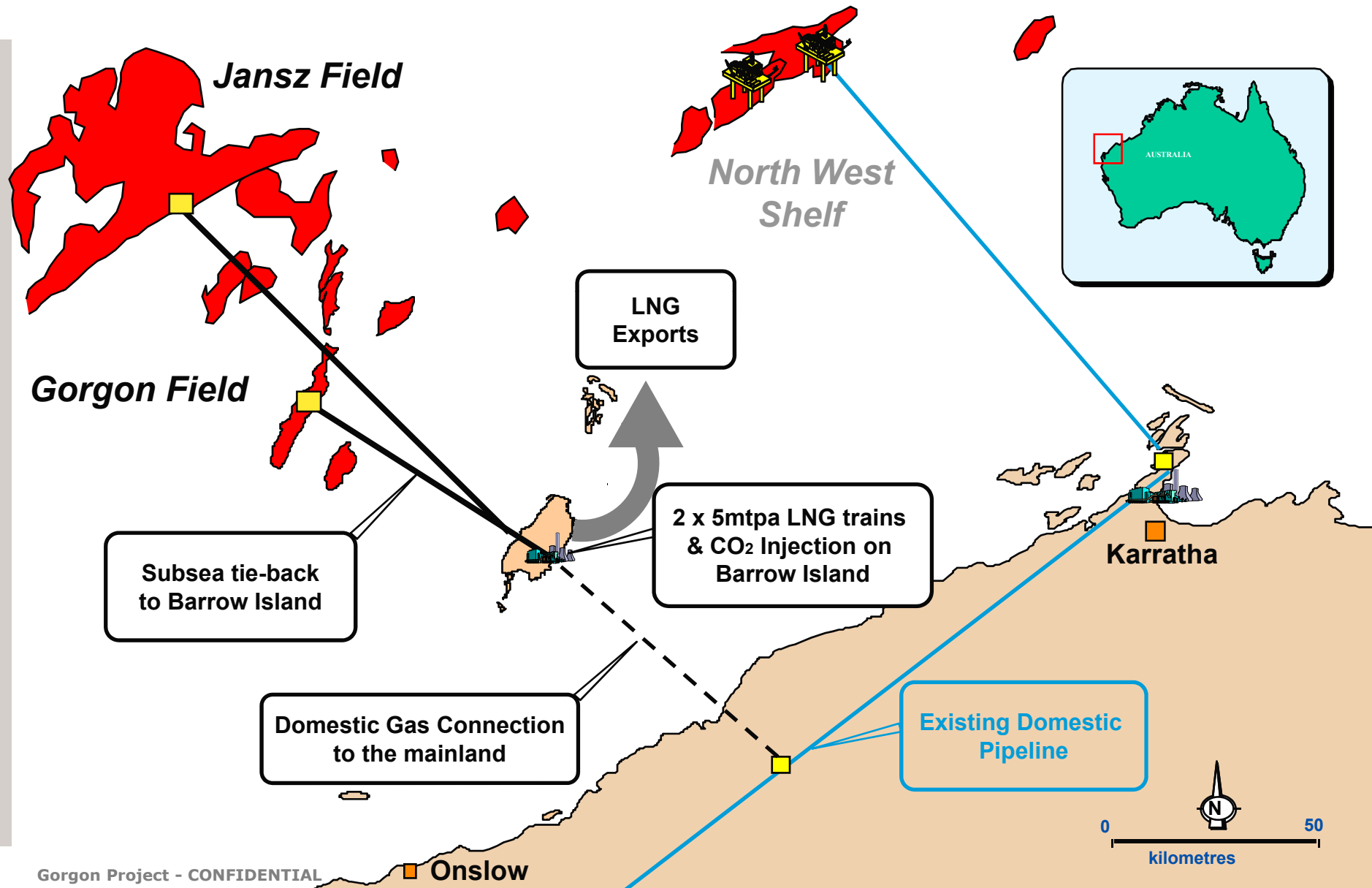




## Gorgon's Significance

- World Scale Project of significance to Chevron, ExxonMobil and Shell
- World's largest greenhouse mitigation project
- \$17+ billion in taxes and royalties
- \$2+ billion export income pa - new/enhanced trade with Japan, India, Korea, USA, China
- 6000 permanent jobs
- 0.3% increase in GDP
